One in the morning and another later in the afternoon as per information from Chhattisgarh Christian Forum. The attackers entered the house Church and vandalized and slapped a 12 year old boy inside the Church. In the other incident on 3.10.2021 in Bhilai, Chattisgarh, Pastor Santosh Rao was summoned to the Charoda Bhilai GRP police station. The police informed him that he was accused of performing a religious conversion and released after he was questioned.
